To The Landfill

Soil, stones, blocks, concrete, slate, rubble, roof tiles, bowling balls, safes (fireproof), etc. (take directly to Higashimizome Landfill Site (22-6890))

Small Animal Corpses

Please bring them to Incinerator or consult with the Waste Management Division (33-7291).

Private Business Trash

Please contact a private garbage disposal company or take the garbage to a disposal facility.

• Recycle Regulation

Air-conditioners, TVs, Refrigerators, washing machines and dryers.

- 1. Please contact the shop you originally purchased the appliances from.
- 2. Please ask the Waste Management Division Operation Office (33-7291) or a licensed private garbage disposal company to help
- Please bring them to Recycle Plaza.
- Please bring them to a designated collection location.

*In any case, recycle charge will be needed. *In case 1 and 2, collection & freight charge will be needed besides the recycle charge.

*In case 3, freight charge will be needed besides the recycle charge.

• Chemicals, tires, tubes, batteries for car/bike, fire extinguishers

Household personal computers (purchased on or after October 2003, or those with the PC recycling mark)

*Please consult your point of purchase or a specialized contractor

• Button-type batteries, rechargeable batteries

If the rechargeable battery can be removed:

- Tape the terminals of removed rechargeable batteries,

and place them in the yellow small rechargeable battery collection/recycling bo

- Place the device from which the battery was removed into the used sma

If the rechargeable battery cannot be removed:

- Place the entire device into the used small appliance collection box
